

DISTRICT SUMMER SCHOOL TUITION

BACKGROUND AND RATIONALE:

FCPS High Schools will offer initial credit summer school classes for Physical Education.

Physical Education sessions will be offered at the following schools: Lafayette High School (June 6-17); Paul L. Dunbar (June 13-24); and Henry Clay High School (session 1 - June 6-17, session 2 – July 11-22).

Tuition costs are used to fund teacher salaries, administrative support, and physical support services as required at the host school. Students who qualify for free/reduced lunch pay reduced tuition rates, and no student is denied access to the program.
