Students are taught how to respond to online bullying




At least 80% of all students are taught how to respond to online bullying (increase of 9%)


We would still like to increase internet access for students when away from school.

Teachers ask students to collaborate online




The data will show that at least 40% of the teachers ask students for collaboration at least monthly. (Increase of 14%)

Teachers post materials online




At least 40% of our teachers will post course materials online. (increase of 12%)


