PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

- All math teachers in the district have been the curriculum alignment process. Teachers have met on multiple occasions to align the standards.
- One of the professional learning days at the beginning of the school year will focus around curriculum alignment and assessment development. Teachers will be working in grade level teams and/or vertical teams to develop assessment questions that match the rigor of the standards.
- On one of the teacher work days in May all staff members will go through the Run, Hide, Fight training. The details for the other day are still in the works. Part of that day will focus around assessment development and curriculum alignment.

ASSESSMENT

- Testing season has begun! Assessment materials have arrived in the district. The Building Assessment Coordinators and I have counted the materials and distributed those materials to the buildings.
- Our KPREP testing window begins on Thursday, May 5. We will be administering KPREP the week of Monday, May 11 – Friday, May 15. Our five day window is Thursday, May 5 – Wednesday, May 11.
- We will be completing the Administrative Code and Special Inclusions training with the middle/high school staff on Wednesday, April 27 and the elementary staff on Monday, May 2.
- End of Course Assessments are scheduled for May 12 and 13.
- COMPASS – juniors wanting to take the Gateway Dual Credit classes and seniors attempting to meet college readiness benchmarks will be attending Gateway on May 6.
- We are finishing up the final round of MAP testing.

CURRICULUM/INSTRUCTION

- All observations for the 2015-2016 school year have been completed. Principals are working through summative evaluations with teachers, which are due May 15.
- Student Voice Survey results have been made available in CIITS for teachers and administrators to view.
- Teachers are finalizing their Student Growth Goals and will soon be giving the final assessment for their student growth goal and finalizing all of their data.
