#### **Good News Report:**

The following Good News items were shared at this meeting:

- A Fine Arts assembly was held on 3/7 for all LES students. The focus was on Appalachian culture.
- Students attended the *Dreamfest* field trip on 3/10 @ NKU.

- Parent Teacher Conferences were held on 3/17 from 3 7pm. Approximately 300 parents attended this event.
- Students have read 14,650 AR books compared to 9,951 books from last year.
- LES 6<sup>th</sup> grade spelling bee winner finished in the top 23 at the regional competition.
- Congratulations to the LES Chess Club for competing very well at the Queen City Classic at Paul Brown Stadium.
- 4-H Speech winners will move to the regional competition on 3/29.

B. <u>Summer Learning Opportunities</u> – Summer School, Me and My School, and 21<sup>st</sup> Century – We are hopeful that the budget will be available to make some of these summer learning opportunities occur for students of Lincoln.

#### **Budget Report:**

- 1. Budget Update Current Balance -- \$2,738.82
- 2. Requisitions -
  - Installments were taken out for the approved *Reading Plus* slots and for the cold laminate.
  - Mr. Duty requested that the SBDM council consider providing \$500 to the updated audio/microphone equipment project. The board of education is providing \$1,600 and the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Program will also be providing \$500 toward the project. Mr. Sparks made a motion to approve giving \$500 to the microphone project. Mrs. Marimon seconded the motion.
  - Mrs. Dragan discussed the recent calculator inventory that occurred by Mrs. Young.
    We are in good shape with working calculators for the upcoming K-Prep state
    testing, but we do need to purchase an additional 35 calculators to be used by our
    fifth and sixth grade students. Mrs. Berringer made a motion to purchase 35 Texas
    Instrument calculators. Mrs. Clayton seconded this motion.
- 3. <u>Budget Allocations</u> Mr. Duty shared a tentative LES budget provided by the board office with the council members. Mr. Duty discussed specific allocations including staffing, teaching supplies, etc.

- F. <u>Second Reading</u> *Consultation Policy* Mr. Duty reviewed the revised policy with discussion being held. Mrs. Clayton made a motion to accept the second reading of the Consultation Policy. Mrs. Berringer seconded the motion.
- G. <u>Policy Review</u> *School Day and Week Schedule Policy* Mr. Duty reviewed this policy and discussion was held regarding specific wording within this policy. Revisions were made by the council and reviewed. A motion by Mrs. Stuempel was made to accept the first reading of this policy. Mrs. Marimon seconded the motion.
