### **Committee Recommended Changes**

- Deliberate Disruption – levels specific to impact <sup>1</sup>minor, <sup>2</sup>moderate, <sup>3</sup>significant
- Failure to follow rules/failure to obey – removed from code

### **Elementary**

- School-level suspension no longer strategy for
  - Leaving school grounds without permission
  - Forgery/counterfeiting
  - Use of tobacco products
  - Theft/vandalism
  - Academic dishonesty
  - Dress code violation
  - Inappropriate use of district technology
  - Violation of personal electronic device
  - Failure to attend detention
  - Loitering
- District-level suspension no longer strategy for
  - Inappropriate sexual behavior (excluding assault/abuse) – school suspension is still an option
  - Fighting/striking student
  - Drug/alcohol possession/under the influence

### **Middle and High Schools**

- School-level suspension no longer a strategy for
  - Forgery/counterfeiting
  - Profanity/vulgarity
  - Gambling
  - Use/possession of tobacco products
  - Academic dishonesty
  - Dress code violation
  - Inappropriate use of district technology
  - Violation of personal electronic device
  - Failure to attend detention
  - Loitering
- District suspension no longer strategy for
  - Inappropriate sexual behavior (excluding assault/abuse) – school suspension is still an option.
  - Theft/Vandalism – school suspension is still an option.
- Range of strategies for drug/alcohol distribution expanded to include administrative strategies to district suspension
