As I write this report there are only four days remaining for all schools, but one, in the 2015 school year. We have had another great year of teaching and learning and we want *to say a very special thank you to our Board of Education for their continued focus on our district motto, "It's ALL ABOUT KIDS". Additionally, I want to say a special thank you to our 1,000+ staff who remain committed to doing "Whatever it takes" for our KIDS!*

All reports indicate that the State Assessment "KPREP" is going very well with our KIDS working extremely hard. Special thank you to our OUSTANDING TEAM for continuing to raise expectations and rigor while at the same time caring for our KIDS. We will reach our goal of being a top 10 school district because of the amazing work of our team, our kids and our parents/community. We just finished the 9th month of school and I am excited to report that our attendance for the 9th month was the highest in Floyd County History at 95.25%. Additionally, at the end of the 9th month we have the highest overall attendance ever in Floyd County at 95.19%. Last Friday night we had 11 students graduate from FCECA. That makes us 39 students who have left school with a high school diploma and an Associate's Degree.
