

# Summer 2016 at Lincoln Elementary

## LES Summer Reading Challenge

Every student will be provided with their very own box to decorate and fill with new and gently-used books. This "little library" will help the students participate in the summer reading challenge, which will include incentives for logging time and books read during the summer months. ## Summer Reading & Learning

Every student going into kindergarten through 6<sup>th</sup> grade will receive a summer learning calendar (grades K & 1) or book (grades 2-6). The purpose of this is to encourage families to learn and read together over the summer! Each student will be expected to take an AR quiz on this book over the summer or by the end of the first week of the new school year.

## Open Library Time

The LES library will be open every Monday AND Wednesday through June and July from 10am- 1pm. Students and their families will be able to use the library space to read together, take AR quizzes, check-out books, etc.

## Intermediate Summer School

Students leaving grades 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup>, who have failed one or more classes OR need extra work in particular subjects, will be asked to attend this rigorous two week program taught by LES teachers. *June 6<sup>th</sup> through June 17<sup>th</sup>*

## "Me and My School"

Students transitioning into kindergarten will participate in this four week program focusing on social and academic skills needed to have a successful beginning to kindergarten. This program is funded through a grant by the *United Way*, will include a weekly parenting component, and will also include a community partner: The Campbell County Library.

## 21<sup>st</sup> Century Summer Program

Through our 21<sup>st</sup> Century Grant we will be offering a five week summer program for approximately 50 - 70 LES students. A combination of academics, summer fun, and field trips will be the focus of this program.

## Primary Jumpstart Program

This program is targeted to help students get back into the swing of school by working with the teachers in the grade level they will be entering. During this two week program, teachers will be working with students on reading and math skills. *July 25<sup>th</sup> – August 5<sup>th</sup>*

## Chess Camp

A weeklong chess camp offered through the Collinsworth Pro Scan Community Fund will be provided to selected students who have shown great interest, enthusiasm, and dedication to learning the game of chess. *July 18<sup>th</sup> – July 22<sup>nd</sup>*
