Recommendation B: The Kentucky Department of Education, where appropriate, should utilize the state educator code of ethics to develop regulations that would support school districts in employee discipline for a violation.

Recommendation C: Work with the Educator Preparation Programs to develop training modules for preservice teacher candidates to complete prior to program completion that are related to the revised code of ethics (Recommendation A).
