What is it? The Governor's Commonwealth Institute for Parent Leadership, also known as **GCIPL**, is a program of the Prichard Committee for Academic Excellence that helps parents and other caring adults learn more about how to support their children in school and engage others to improve the academic outcomes of all students in their school.

Who can attend? This leadership program is available to parents, caregivers, and mentors of public school students in the following counties: Boone, Bracken, Campbell, Gallatin, Grant, Kenton and Pendleton County.

What will I learn? Participants receive information about Kentucky's public education and accountability system, how to analyze student and school achievement data, regional resources and supports, and communication and leadership skills needed to engage others in school improvement projects.

Costs and dates? Participants receive five days of training, which includes meals and materials, at **NO COST** to them. Participants must commit to attend all 5 days of training that will be held on August 26-27, September 30 - October 1, and October 29, 2016.
