Recommendation/Motion: Authorize the Superintendent to execute the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), and all subsequent documents (except the deed, which will be executed by the Board Chair) required to finalize the agreed transaction set out therein and as agreeable to the Superintendent, from Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government (LFUCG) regarding the construction identified as the Paradise Lane Pump Station and Force Main on the Martin Luther King Academy / Liberty Road Bus Garage site. The MOU outlines conveyance of approximately 7,075 SF (0.16 acres) of land to LFUCG for a pump station; granting a 20-foot permanent sanitary sewer easement on school property of 3,153 SF; and granting a temporary construction easement of 14,300 SF; all for which FCPS will be paid \$14,000.00.

Background/Rationale: The neighborhood to the northwest of Martin Luther King Academy and the Liberty Road Bus Garage is receiving a new sanitary sewer system. The LFUCG project named the Paradise Lane Pump Station and Force Main is designed and ready for bidding by LFUCG, with construction expected to begin in mid-summer and extend into next school year. This project will disturb the southeast corner of the school site. Conditions have been included in the Memorandum of Understanding that will require LFUCG to repair or replace any and all school property disturbed or damaged. This work requires a temporary construction easement (14,300 SF) for access to the school property. This sanitary sewer line requires a 20-foot permanent sanitary sewer easement on the Martin Luther King Academy / Liberty Bus Garage property of 3,163 SF. The work will be provided at no cost to FCPS. An appraisal report has been prepared by Bluegrass Valuation Group establishing the total just compensation of \$14,000.00 to be paid to FCPS.
