Background/Rationale: The Fayette County Board of Education is committed to a successful transition for every student making an out of community placement back into Fayette County Public Schools. Those who leave the community for a substantive period are eligible to participate in the Reintegration of Students' Effective Transition Panel (R.E.S.E.T). The purpose of the panel is:

- To provide recommendations and accommodations needed for school placement.
- Report recommendations to the Middle or High School Director.

The School Director(s), in collaboration with the R.E.S.E.T. Panel authorizes the placement decision. Students with special education services are directed to the Admissions and Release Committee (ARC) placement decisions.

Policy: FCPS BOE adopted Top Ten Equity Council Recommendations: #8 R.E.S.E.T. Panel for students' reintegration back into FCPS. When a student comes into the district from an outside placement late in the semester (e.g. two weeks before the end of school), there should be a transition setting to get them reintegrated into the system effectively
