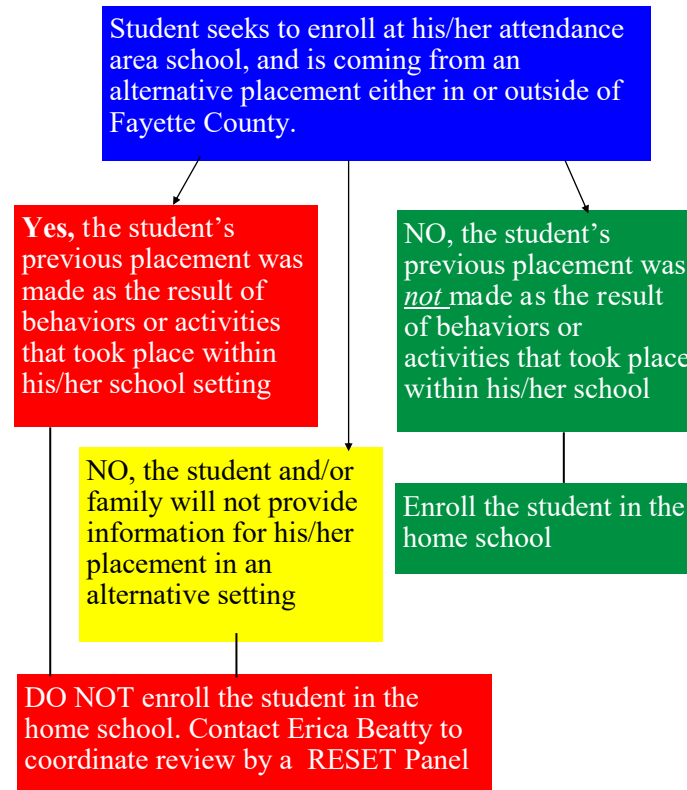


R. E. S. E. T. Panel Process

The Fayette County Board of Education is committed to a successful transition for every student making an out of community placement back to Fayette County Public Schools. Those who leave the community for a substantive period are eligible to participate in the Reintegration of Students' Effective Transition Panel (R.E.S.E.T)



The Procedure



Composition of the Panel

The panel is made up of:

- Student Placement Coordinator
- Administrators of community agencies such as the Cabinet for Health and Family Services
- The Department of Juvenile Justice
- Coordinator of Mental Health Services
- FCPS Equity Council representative
- Special Education Director
- Representative from the Urban County Government.

All panel members are required to sign a confidentiality form.

Case Presentation

Professional advocates for the student can contribute pertinent information. Parents and students may attend the presentation.



Deadlines/Timelines

- Submission of application and documentation.
- Assessment of the application
- The panel gives their recommendations to the director directly following the meeting.
- The director has 24 hours to read the recommendations and authorize the placement.
- The parent, worker and home school are notified within the 24 hour period.
- Students receiving special education services, will be directed to special Education.

Purpose of the Panel

The purpose of the panel is:

- To provide recommendations and accommodations needed for school placement.
- Report recommendations to the middle or high School Director.

The School Director, in collaboration with the R.E.S.E.T. Panel authorizes the placement decision.

Students with special education services are directed to the Admissions and Release Committee (ARC) placement decisions.
