ACTION PLAN UPDATE

1. Status Update

- i** The Fleming County Board of Education has a current balance of \$600,000. The current working budget has a 6% contingency.

District leadership has conducted internal reviews of teaching and learning at each school and is using the findings to create a district action plan to strategically provide targeted support for each school. The process is now being refined for 2016-17 to address the concerns from principals, teachers and other stakeholders, as well as provide schools with targeted feedback and next steps.

Due to scheduling and a focus on the success of students at the high school, the district has scheduled an accreditation visit (external review) for the spring of 2017.

The district continues to focus on the following five improvement priorities the district has identified as critical: 1) engagement of all students; 2) development of a common curriculum and common assessments; 3) data and student work analysis through professional learning communities; 4) empowerment of all stakeholders through share leadership; and 5) connection of the systems.

Furthermore, all five components must be regularly monitored and evaluated.

2. Action Strategies - Completion

- i** The district has finalized the strategic plan and uploaded it to KASA Connect. Final approval by the Fleming County Board of Education is scheduled for May and June 2016.

The district is now in the second stage of the transportation audit. The district is working to finalize next steps and preparing for the 2016-17 school year.

The district has created the District Support for School Improvement Instrument. The instrument is a dashboard of data that focuses on student achievement, engagement, staff attendance, school processes and supports.

3. Action Strategies - Deficiencies

- i** The district has a focus on implementing a district-wide curriculum in all courses. The district is providing support to the high school over the summer to finalize the curriculum and identify resources.

4. Action Strategies – Additions

- i** The district is currently trying to finalize summer plans around curriculum development and resource allocations.

The district is still reviewing the possibilities of scheduling a District Office transformation audit.

The district is finalizing the agenda and dates for the 2nd Annual Fleming County Schools Administrator and Teacher Leader Retreat.
