Recommendation/Motion: Approve the proposed additive Change Order No. Twelve to the contract with D.W. Wilburn, Inc. for the construction of Coventry Oak Elementary School in the amount of \$5,742.36 (Five Thousand, Seven Hundred Forty-two Dollars and Thirty-six Cents), and a decrease in the DPOs of \$5,647.00 (Five Thousand, Six Hundred Forty-seven Dollars), with an equivalent transfer of funds from Object Code 0840 to 0450, and a corresponding transfer of \$263.56 (Two Hundred Sixty-three Dollars and Fifty-six Cents) for design consultant fees from Object Code 0840 to 0346, subject to the approval of the Kentucky Department of Education, District Facilities Branch, per the provisions of 702 KAR 4:160.

Background/Rationale: The construction of the new elementary school to be located on 15 acres at the intersection of Georgetown and Spurr Roads is listed as priority 1a.5 on FCPS's 2013 District Facility Plan. Clotfelter-Samokar Architects produced final Construction Documents for bidding describing the construction of a new building totaling approximately 73,000 SF to serve 650 students, based upon FCPS elementary school program standards. Bids were received on January 15, 2015 and construction began in April, 2015. The Office of Facility Design & Construction, the design consultants and the local building code officials have reviewed the progress of the work. Changes to the original plans and specifications have been necessary in order to satisfy the requirements described below. Approval of these changes allows the work to be completed. The description and cost of these items are summarized as follows:

To improve original plans and specs:

- Correction to Change Order # 11 -- Provide labor, materials and equipment to remove (150) 4" and (150) 6" vinyl letters from project, with a credit to (1) DPO add:
 - Atlas Companies (DPO# 35508173)
- Provide labor, materials and equipment to delete labor to install (20) 16" plastic letters, (21) 8" plastic letters and 64" dia. Logo and install (21) 8" cast aluminum letters on exterior of building above entrance, with a credit to (1) DPO; deduct:
