



**FLOYD COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION**  
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**Action/Discussion Item:** Request approval of the 2016-17 District Private School Plan

**Applicable Statutes or Regulations:** 707 KAR 1:370.

Under the Individuals with Disabilities Act (IDEA), districts are required to provide services to eligible private school children/youth. A portion of the federal funds received by the local district must be designated for these students. The district has the final decision in determining the services to be provided, following a consultation meeting with the parents and representatives for the private school children with disabilities.

**Fiscal Budgetary Impact:** The Kentucky Department of Education calculates the proportionate amount of the IDEA budget that is to be used for students with disabilities in the private schools. These funds will pay for the services.


**Alternatives:** None proposed.

**Recommended Action:** It is recommended that the private school plan be approved.

- Services that will be provided:  
The following related services will be provided as determined by the Admissions and Release Committee, and documented in the Private school service plan: Speech/Language Therapy
- Children/Youth who will receive services under a service plan:  
Those private school students who meet eligibility requirements for speech/language services according to the Kentucky Administrative Regulations for Special Education Programs and the Floyd County Policies and Procedures Manual.
- How and Where will the services be provided:  
Certified Speech Language Pathologists employed by or contracted with the Floyd County School District, will provided the services as documented in the IPSP. The service will be provided at Floyd County School sites and/or Private school sites located in Floyd County, as determined by the Floyd County Schools to eligible private school children. The services will be provided as allocated funds allow.
- How will the services be evaluated:  
Services will be evaluated using on-going progress data and district evaluation procedures. Service Plans (IPSP) will be reviewed/revised periodically, but no less than annually.
