The College Ready Writing Project is a collaboration between the Louisville Writing Project and Jefferson County Public Schools. The sub-award totals \$1,649 for the following services: Teachers from Olmsted Academy North will attend training to learn College Ready Writing instructional strategies to use with students. Nine substitute days are required for this training. The training sessions will occur in September 2016. The district will pay Board-approved substitute salary and benefit rates. Indirect costs are included at the district's federally approved rate.

The professional development will provide teachers with instructional and formative assessment resources that focus on reading and analyzing multiple perspectives on important issues, developing strong claims, and effectively using nonfiction texts as evidence.
