

OHIO COUNTY OPERATION AND MANAGEMENT PLAN – ROAD DEPARTMENT

I. Description of County

The Ohio County, KY Fiscal Court maintains a Sheriff's department, Volunteer Fire department, and administrative department.

II. Management

The governing body of the County is a six member Fiscal Court, all of whom are elected by the citizens of Ohio County. The County Judge Executive and Magistrates are ultimately responsible for operations of all county functions, including the road department.

III. Operation

The County Judge Executive supervises the day to day operations of the county.

IV. Maintenance

The county has various equipment as needed for performance of department duties including trucks, radio equipment, graders, and various other types of specialized equipment needed in performance of official duties of the County. If there should be a need for services which cannot be met by county employees and equipment, contract services or assistance from other sources will be obtained to accomplish the needed task.

V. Compliance With Federal, State, and Local Laws

The Ohio County Fiscal Court will be operated in compliance with all known federal, state, and local laws, ordinances, and codes.

VI. Audits and Reports

The Ohio County Fiscal Court and the Green River Regional Industrial Development Authority will provide management reports as required by the Rural Housing Service.

VII. Miscellaneous

The Ohio County Fiscal Court, or the Green River Regional Industrial Development Authority will acquire and maintain required liability and real property insurance, including vehicular insurance, workman's compensation, position fidelity bond coverage, and any other special insurance that may be needed.
