Proposal for a District Special Education Assessment and Compliance Coach

Building leadership opportunities within the district in order to accommodate for the critical shortage of a school psychologist. This position will assist the Director of Special Education in managing district wide assessments for special education, coach teachers on compliance with student records, assessments, IEP development, and input of assessment data into Infinite Campus. For the 2014-2015 school year we were under a Corrective Action Plan for Indicator 11 (60 day timelines). By establishing this stipend position, it will help our district establish efficient and effective evaluation procedures that will meet federally established timelines. A DACC will coach other teachers on the basic duties related to Due Process paperwork compliance, progress monitoring, IEP development, and overall how to run an efficient, organized, student-centered ARC.
