PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

- We have had two Early Release Meetings that have focused on vertical curriculum alignment. We have had primary teachers meet in their grade level groups and all teachers in grades 4 – 12 meet in content groups. These meetings rotate back and forth from LES and DHS. We also have content specialists from the co-op attend the meetings.
- On September 19 and 20, Mr. Brewer and Mr. Kellinghaus attended the Continuous Improvement Conference.
- On Monday, September 12, we had our brand new teachers attend the first ever Regional New Teacher PLC.
- We are having 7 teachers attend a KAGAN training on Thursday, September 29.

ASSESSMENT

- On Wednesday, September 14, a webcast was held for District Assessment Coordinators to take one last comprehensive look at district data. The data will be released under embargo on Tuesday, September 27 to superintendents in the morning and the media in the afternoon through the School Report Card. The embargo will be lifted and the School Report Card will go live on Thursday, September 29 at 12:01 a.m.
- LES has finished MAP testing, and DHS will begin CERT testing in a couple of weeks.

CURRICULUM/INSTRUCTION

- Teachers are working on the Student Growth Goals, Self-Reflection and PGP, which all need submitted prior to Fall Break.
- During the Curriculum Alignment Early Release Wednesday's, teachers are completing Unit/Quarterly Organizers, a Curriculum Timeline for each class, and are beginning to develop quarterly assessments.
- Weekly PLC's are underway at the high school as well as Flashback/Standard meetings at the elementary school.
