The Family Resource Center participated in the Southgate Readifest on August 11th. Shiloh Schweitzer distributed forms for registration and Rob Sanders cooked and served hot dogs to students and families.

Shiloh Schweitzer participated in transitioning pre-school students into the school in September.

Ms. Schweitzer and Mr. Sanders made home visits to students who were at or near the first level of potential truancy in their attendance. They made 14 home visits either speaking with parents or leaving an introductory letter for each family.

Mr. Sanders and Ms. Schweitzer will both be attending One-To-One Reading Training in October and will serve as Coaches for students throughout the year.

Mr. Sanders and Ms. Schweitzer met with Ms. Green, Media Specialist, to begin planning for a Literacy Night event that will be held on December 6th in conjunction with the Book Fair. The theme for the event will be “Pirates”

The Family Resource Center will assist with the Reading Program by assuming the cost for incentive prizes.

During October we will be assessing need for families for participation in both the Thanksgiving baskets for families and for the Holiday, Christmas Assistance Program. Families may be referred through teachers, staff, administration or referred to us by friends or family members.
