History/Background: The Floyd County School District has continued to participate in the Community Eligibility Program successfully now for the past 5 years. As a result, we have seen higher participation rates from each of our schools over that period of time. As a result, revenue has increased during that time period. The creation of the position of School Nutrition Supervising Manager will help to continuously improve the quality of our school nutrition program. This position will focus on improving consistency in the areas of safety, food preparation, quality of meals, inventory management, staff training, and monitoring of the day to day operations in the school nutrition department at all of the Floyd County Schools.
