Severe Weather Preparedness

This session focuses on before, during, and after school scenarios that administrators must consider in preparing for natural disasters.

Hiding in Plain Sight

This session details the innovative methods that students use to bring illegal substances into the schools.

Bullying Prevention

Training sessions vary according to the audience. To students, presentations are geared toward assistance to the victims, end of labeling, etc. The staff version involves recognition of subtle bullying, reporting techniques, investigative options, and programs to curtail bullying.

Terroristic Threatening in Schools

Discussion and recommendations of responses to bomb threats, hit lists, restroom wall graffiti, social media threats, etc.

Gatekeeper

Dealing with angry people or "Getting difficult people to do what you want them to do and make them think it's their idea!"

Bus Driver training

School bus drivers are introduced to concepts of PBIS and positive interaction techniques with students. Emphasis is placed on developing productive ongoing relationships with students.

Situational Awareness

The ability to assess and react to situations at school, home, or in the community can often lead to life-saving results. Whether you are faced with an incredibly rare situation like a shooting spree in a public place or a more typical situation like a purse snatching, training is the key.

Social Media and Employees

The use of social media by employees, good or bad? Most of our employees today have not experienced a life without instant information and communication through various means of technology. This training will highlight policies used by educational as well as other agencies to guide employees to use technology in a safe manner.
