Bend Gate Elementary is applying for a "Read To Achieve" grant from the KY Department of Education. The grant will provide two years of reading intervention support for K-1 Bend Gate students. The grant funding is for \$50,000 per year for two years .

Grant funds will be used for hiring a Reading Interventionist to work with identified K-1 students. The grant funding will begin August 2017 and continue until June 30, 2019.
