KDE training was presented to members at the first meeting of the LPC which was held on October 8, 2016. Committee members received an overview of the Comprehensive Infrastructure Assessment and potential recommendations.

Dr. Raisor and team participated in an in depth discussion with committee members present at the second LPC meeting on November 1, 2016. Discussion of potential recommendations to the Board and administration, emphasis on Five (5) Year recommendations. Approved at this meeting were the Finding to Change the Status of 13700 Sandray Boulevard, the former Frost Middle School building from a Permanent Center to a Transitional Center and approval to submit Draft Plan to KDE.

5-Year Recommendations

- Better school level maintenance structure – in Process
- Free Standing ESL Newcomer Academy
- Free Standing Early Childhood Centers
- Consolidation of Offices and Programs
- One-time Energy Savings Investments
- Fund Maintenance based on need (zero based)
- Reduction/repurposing of campuses
- Create a community supported plan for future
- Modern Security and Access Systems in all schools
- Construct new modern facilities in cases where renovation cost is excessive.
- Centralized athletic and arts facilities
