6 RELATES TO: KRS 158.148, 158.150

7 STATUTORY AUTHORITY: KRS 156.070, 158.148

8 NECESSITY, FUNCTION, AND CONFORMITY: This is to repeal 704 KAR 7:050, Student

9 discipline guidelines. The administrative regulation was promulgated in

10 KRS 156.070 authorizes the Kentucky Board of Education to promulgate administrative

11 regulations necessary for the efficient management, control, and operation of the schools and

12 programs under its jurisdiction; and KRS 158.148 requires the Kentucky Department of Education

13 to develop guidelines containing broad principles to guide local school districts in developing their

14 own student discipline codes.

15 This administrative regulation established the student discipline guidelines required by KRS

16 158.148. This administrative regulation repeals 704 KAR 7:050, Student discipline guidelines,

17 because it is not necessary to house the student discipline guidelines in regulation as they are not

18 binding upon school districts and to be reviewed and potentially revised every two years per KRS

19 158.148.

20 Section 1. 704 KAR 7:050, Student discipline guidelines, is hereby repealed.

This is to certify that the chief state school officer has reviewed and recommended this administrative regulation prior to its adoption by the Kentucky Board of Education, as required by KRS 156.070(5).
