Nov. 14-15	Restorative Leadership development or Restorative Leadership Retreats (2 Days) - Keith suggests we combine content with prep and planning. (24)
Dec. 5-6	Basic Climate Training (2 Days) - important to frame restorative practices under the umbrella of school climate (24)
Jan. 9-10	Introduction to RP (1 Day) - basic concepts of restorative practices key to pedagogy (24-45)  Using Circles Effectively (1 Day) - hands on practice using various types of circles to facilitate restorative practices (24-45)
Jan 30-31	Facilitating Restorative Conferences (2 Days) - simulated training on facilitating formal conferencing in response to harmful behavior. (24-45)
Feb. 6	Family Engagement and Empowerment (1 Day) - approaches to effectively engaging families across the continuum. (24-45)
Feb 22-23	Restorative Responses to Adversity and Trauma (2 Days) - employ restorative practices to respond effectively to serious incidents related to trauma (24-45)
March 6-7	Motivational Interviewing: Restorative Dialogue and Intervention for Change (2 Days) - bring awareness to individuals about the discrepancy between their current behavior and their future goals (24-45)

<b>May 25-26</b>	<b>HIGH SCHOOL TRAINING DATE - alternate 2 day whole school training for demo schools</b>  <b>On-Boarding for 7 of the 14 additional schools</b>
<b>Summer 17</b>	<b>On-Boarding for the last 7 schools</b>
