

Assessment Overview




Habitually under-funded, thus undermaintained, resulting in triage as standard operating procedure




Non-Negotiables


Our decisions fall in this priority order

- 1. Effective
- 2. Systemically Coherent
- 3. Operationally Efficient

Two Levels



- 1. Initiatives that can begin and be implemented immediately.
- 2. Initiatives that can begin, but cannot start to be logistically implemented until the 2018-2019 school year.



Better School Level Maintenance Structure

- School based maintenance staff supervised by Operations staff with expertise and knowledge in building maintenance
- Necessary Supplies and tools provided by the district, not the school's budget.



Fund maintenance based on the actual need

- Necessary repairs, replacements, and maintenance must be funded.
- Follow industry standards for the upkeep of our schools.



Energy Savings Investments

- LED Lighting
- New windows
- Geothermal heating and cooling
- Solar power



Standardized Security & Access Systems

- Digital Cameras
- Managed Access Control
- Centralized Alarm and monitoring
- Funded and managed by Security
