Student Achievement Report

- A. <u>School-wide MAP Testing (Winter Benchmark)</u> MAP winter benchmark testing comparison report of reading and math comparison of Fall to Winter. Mrs. Dragan will be working on a vertical MAP report. During the next round of MAP benchmark tests we are going to give out the MAP ribbons in the lab immediately when students complete their tests.
- B. <u>Intermediate Report Cards- 2nd quarter Update</u> Mrs. Dragan shared with council members the great accomplishments from our intermediate students only 8 kids on a contract to pass this is very low compared to other years and quarters; no failing grades in fifth grade; the high percentage of students meeting their AR goals; etc.

School Improvement Planning

- 1. Committee Team Updates:
 - <u>Curriculum Team</u> Work continues during our early-release Wednesday sessions with curriculum team members leading this work in their grade level/content groups. (Pacing guides, quarterly organizers, common assessment, etc.)
 - <u>PBIS/Core Life Team</u> Presented to the staff information about the program. Staff survey was completed and they will be analyzing the data. The second training is in Februrary.
 - <u>Instructional Practices Team</u> The team will be analyze a Science curriculum, "Stemscopes" in February.
- 2017-2018 Needs Assessment Committee Brainstormed ideas to include on the Needs Assessment - primary intervention specialist, Science resources, and tech devices (I-pads, Surface Pro etc.), computer or music specials teachers, furniture(tables), book room, de-escalation room, playground, curtains, bulletin boards, keyless entry to the building
