Consent Agenda Item (Action Item): Betsy Layne High School Junior Class requests permission to host their annual Project Prom at Gatti Land in Pikeville from midnight on Saturday, April 29th through the morning of Sunday, April 30th.

Applicable Statute or Regulation: Board Policy 01.11 General Powers and Duties of the Board of Education

Fiscal/Budgetary Impact: The Junior class has raised the amount of money needed to hold project prom at Gatti Land. Games, food, and prizes for students are included in expense.

History/Background: Project Prom has been successfully held at Betsy Layne High School for a number of years. Project Prom is the school's effort to keep students safe and participating in meaningful activity after prom. The event serves as a lock-in and no students are allowed to leave until their legal parent/guardian is called. The event has been quite successful in recent years- we average 100-150 students participating. The students will be bussed to Gatti's and back to BLHS on an every other hour (as needed) basis at 2 AM, 4 AM, and all students remaining at 6 AM.

Recommended Action: Floyd County Board of Education allows Betsy Layne High School to host their annual Project Prom at Gatti Land.
