**PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT**

- For the February PD this year “teacher experts” and “outside experts” presented on various topics during breakout sessions in the morning and in the afternoon LES teachers worked on curriculum alignment and DHS teachers had a presenter, Kim Strobel, discuss standards based grading and assessment.

**ASSESSMENT**

- Naomi Colliver, Casaundra Newsome, and I attended the DAC/BAC assessment training to be updated on the assessment and accountability system.
- Upcoming HS Testing
  - The WorkKeys is taking place March 28.
  - The ACT is on March 21.
  - The KOSSA is taking place on March 14.
  - Juniors and seniors will take the ASVAB on April 11.
  - Seniors take the KYOTE assessment April 18.
- LES Testing
  - LES has KPREP in May but multiple grade levels have been completing live scoring to prep for the upcoming KPREP.
- All five of our ESS students have completed the ACCESS testing.

**CURRICULUM/INSTRUCTION**

- We have five “Deeper Dive” Walkthroughs left to complete. For nine of our grade levels/content areas, we have completed two walkthroughs with one walkthrough focusing on classroom environment and one walkthrough focusing on classroom instruction.
- The spring LEAD report has been submitted.
- Teachers have completed Peer Observations and students will be completing Student Voice Surveys in the next month.
- We are currently working on the Civil Rights Data Collection for the federal government. This data collection is based on the 2015 – 2016 school year.
