- A. <u>School-wide MAP Testing (Winter Vertical Benchmark Analysis)</u> MAP winter vertical benchmark testing analysis report was shared for reading and math comparison of winter data over multiple years. The third round of Map testing will occur next month in March and reports will go home in April.
- B. AIMS web School-wide Progress Report-

The council reviewed various school-wide reading reports from our most recent AIMSweb benchmarking. The reading reports included data in the areas of: comprehension and fluency for students in grades 2 - 6 and letter naming and sound for kindergarten and first grade. Mrs. Dragan will bring math data to share next month.
