College and Career Readiness

Goal - Increase our current CCR percentage (78%) of students identified as college and/or career ready by 5/26/17 as measured by the Next Generation Learners Achievement Data on the School Report Card.

CCR Training and Support	District and school leaders are monitoring CCR status of all students and putting appropriate interventions in place to assist students in meeting college and career readiness benchmarks.	These interventions are currently taking place. If students do not meet benchmarks, we are looking at alternate dates for students to take the ACT.
CERT Testing	CERT Testing has been completed this school year. Teachers are using the data from CERT to assist with interventions.	We are still in the learning stages with CERT. Mr. K and I have spoken with the CERT representative and we are continually looking at ways to improve the administration of CERT and looking at effective ways to use the CERT data.
Early Bird Class	This class has been going on all school year. There are a number of students that will become career ready because of taking this class.	Look at class requests and determine the need to offer an early bird class.
Operation Preparation	We have taken part in Operation Preparation since its inception. Actually, we were having a "College and Career Week" prior to Operation Preparation.	Operation Preparation and College Signing Day will take place in April.
CCR Monitoring (Tracking)	The HS Counselor and Director of Teaching and Learning are continuously monitoring the college and career readiness status of every senior.	Continue monitoring the CCR data.
Career Pathways Communication	The TEDS Coordinator at the high school tracks all students' career pathways.	Continue tracking the career pathways students are enrolled.
