Henderson County High School CTE program is applying for a KY Work Ready Skills Initiative grant in conjunction with Henderson Community College, Union County and Webster County for the purchase of equipment to support Advanced Manufacturing Pathways of Engineering, Welding and Machining. The grant will be a one-time funding opportunity provided through the Ky Workforce Cabinet.

Grant funds will be used for purchasing additional equipment including PLTW equipment, lathes, CNC mills and welding equipment. The grants will be announced in May, 2017 and the equipment will be purchased in phases beginning in July, 2017.

Grant funds will pay all project costs.
