Ongoing Programs/Services

- **Food Pantry** Students and their families continue to utilize the school based food pantry as needed.
- **Counseling** Both NorthKey Community Care and Greater Cincinnati Behavioral Health are available in the building throughout the 2016-2017 school year.
- **Big Devil/Little Devil Mentoring** Mentors have been paired with 7th and 8th grade mentees, and are meeting on a weekly basis.
- **Student Assistance Team** The SAT continues to meet monthly to identify and provide interventions to at risk students. The team is working with identified students and data measuring impact is gathered weekly.
