








#### **Key Findings**


- 66,341 links were made across 146 JCPS schools/sites through the 7<sup>th</sup> Pupil Month.
- 23,593 students have been linked with a resource to help meet a need.
- 7,542 (32%) of students had 2 or more needs linked with a resource.
