





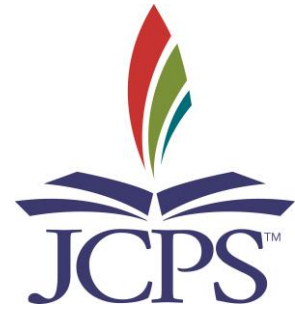

Through 135 School Days (03/20/2017)

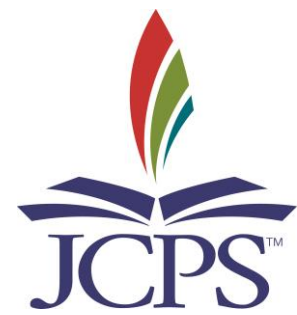


Student Average Daily Attendance Rates

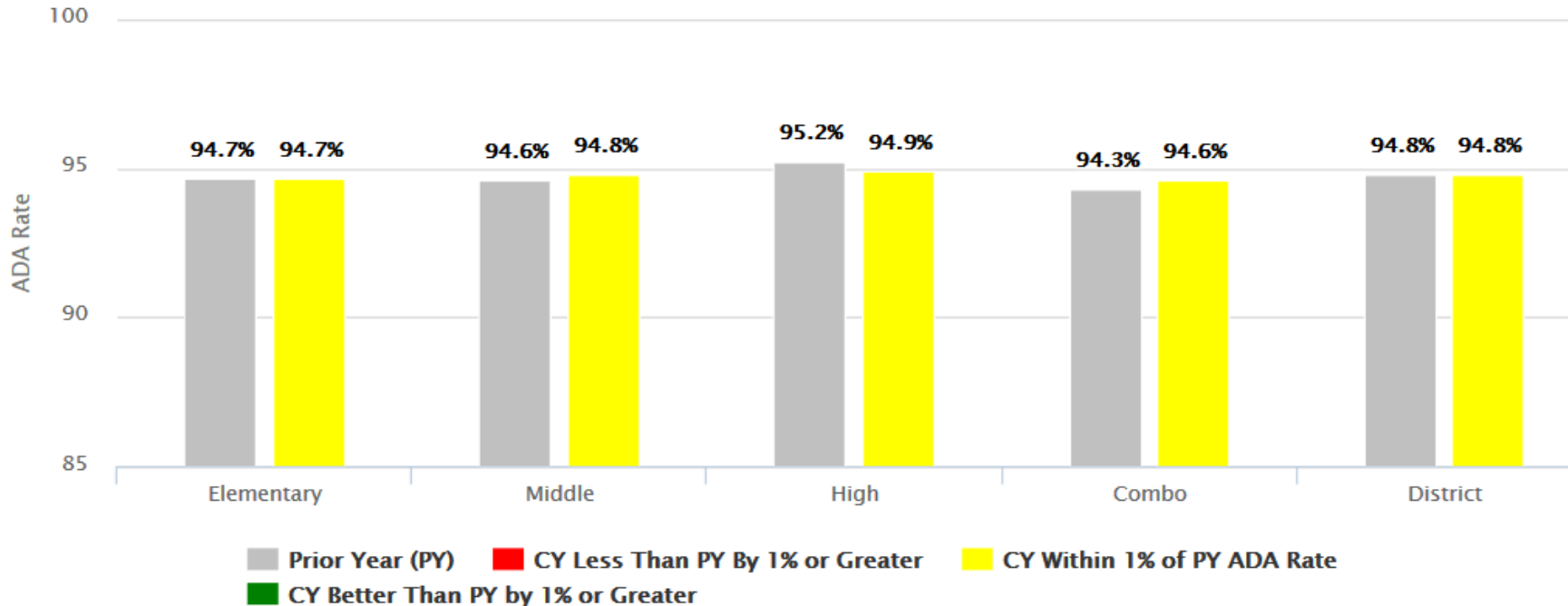

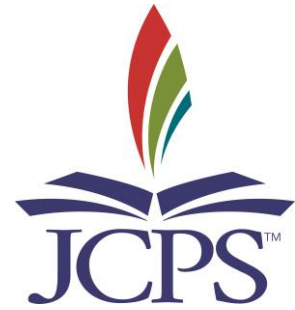


Staff Average Daily Attendance Rate

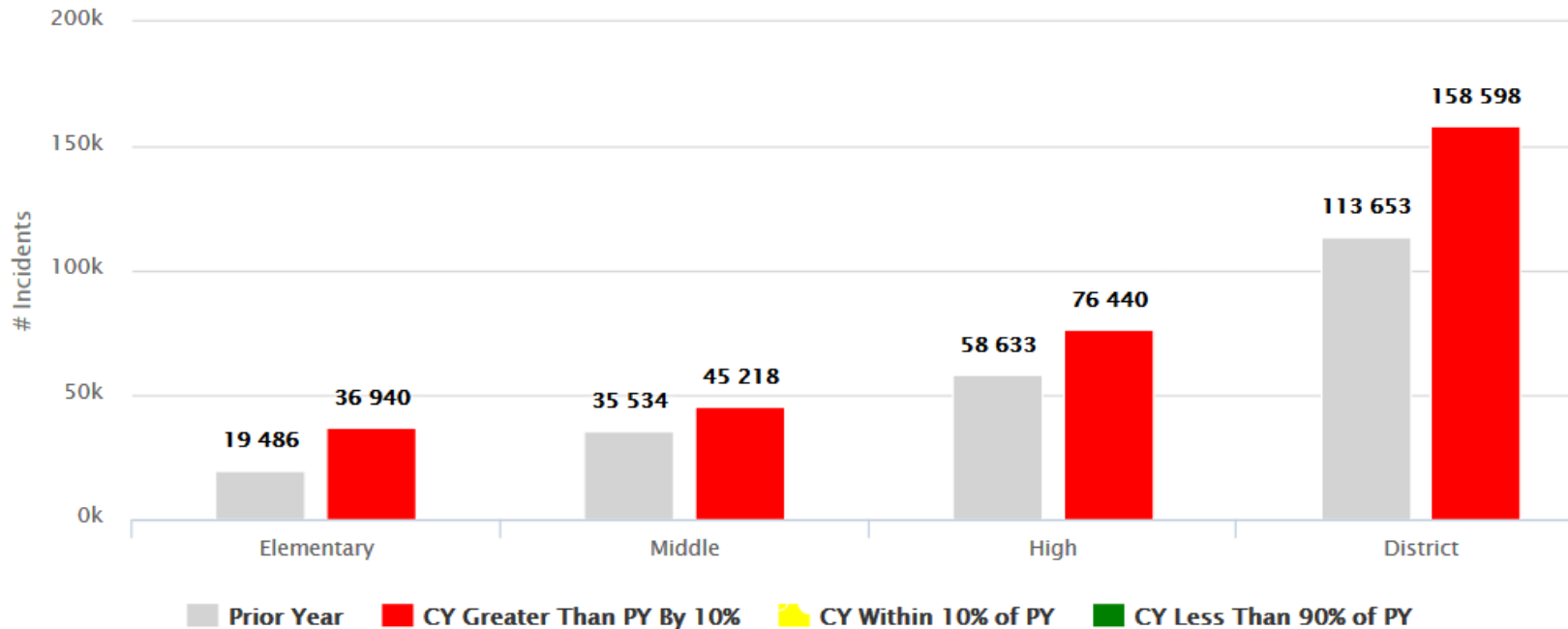

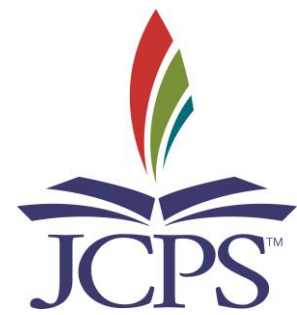


Total Behavior Occurrences

All Students Involved in All Behavior Events

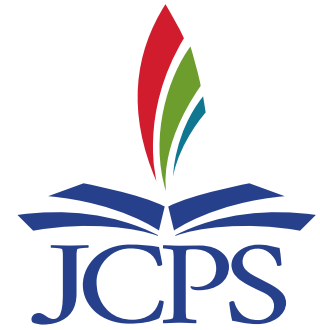

Key Findings



- 66,341 links were made across 146 JCPs schools/sites through the 7th Pupil Month.
- 23,593 students have been linked with a resource to help meet a need.
- 7,542 (32%) of students had 2 or more needs linked with a resource.

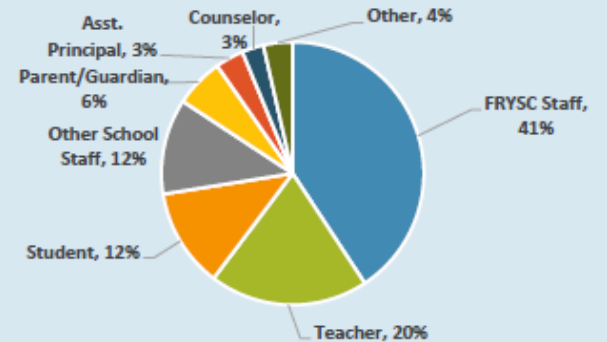
Cumulative Number of Students Served and Links Made

Through Pupil Month 7

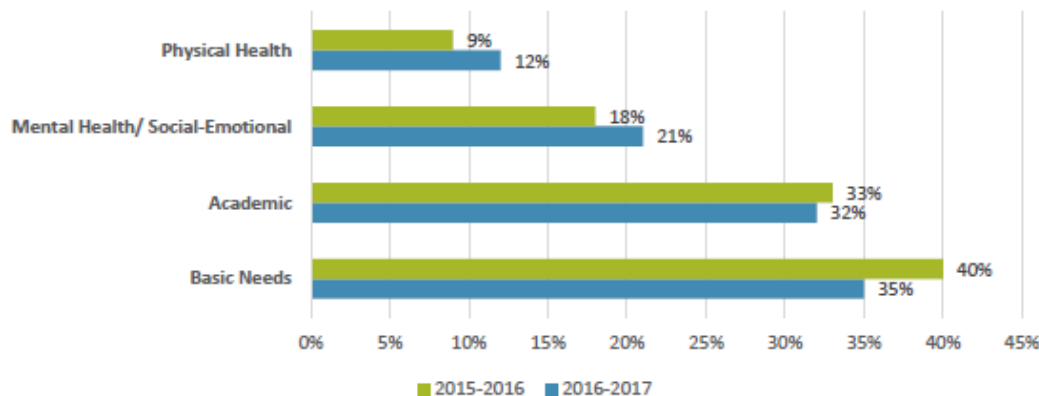

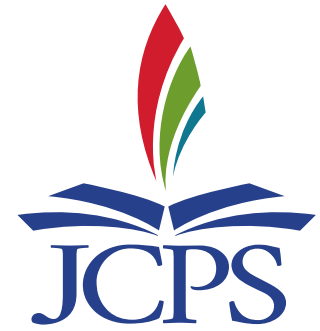
Who is making the referrals?



Types of Links: This Year vs. Last Year



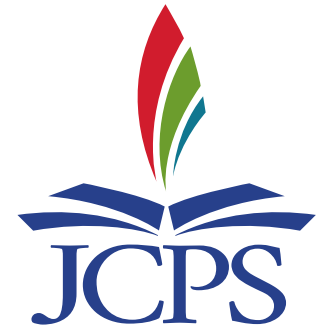
Note: Mental Health and Physical Health Needs have increased this year compared to last year.
