## **Progress Report**

## **Work Completed**

All punch list work is nearing completion. A final walk through was conducted on January 10, 2014 with Owner and Contractor. Very few items remain from the punch list. The corrective work at the auxiliary gymnasium is the only major outstanding item.



Per Morel Construction's update, all punch list items have been complete except the following issues:

- 1. Main Gymnasium electrical punchlist
- 2. North Bleacher Issue at Main Gymnasium (Warranty Issue) Manufacturer has been notified.
- 3. Small Gymnasium Insulation Correction.
  - Morel has emailed a proposal to paint the insulation (as installed) per the
    manufacturer's recommendation for painting the K13 acoustical insulation.
    Documentation has been provided from the subcontractor stating the acoustical
    properties of the insulation will not be compromised as long as the painting is
    completed per the manufacturer's recommendation. SCB is currently reviewing the
    submitted information.

SCB will back check the items on Monday, March 13th and make a recommendation for payment.
