Senate Resolution No. 42
Thursday, February 23, 2017*

Senator Mike Wilson introduced the following resolution which was ordered to be printed.

A Resolution acknowledging the eight winners of the College Board's Seventh Annual Advanced Placement District Honor Roll: Boyd County Schools; Campbellville Independent Schools; Daviess County Schools; Dawson Springs Independent Schools; Fort Thomas Independent Schools, which has received the honor for multiple years; Livingston County Schools; Muhlenberg County Schools; and Pulaski County Schools, which has received the honor for multiple years.

Whereas, these districts are being awarded for simultaneously increasing access to Advanced Placement (AP) coursework while maintaining or increasing the percentage of students earning successful scores on AP exams; and

Whereas, the Commonwealth of Kentucky supports the Advanced Placement program through Advance Kentucky and through strong state policies that grow and expand the program; and

Whereas, these supports are reflected in student gains ranking the Commonwealth 10th in the nation in growth over the past 10 years in the percentage of its graduating high school classes achieving successful AP exam scores; and

Whereas, Advanced Placement is a powerful resource in helping the Commonwealth meet its goal of ensuring that all students graduate from high school ready for college and careers, and are prepared for a more complex and competitive workplace;

Now, Therefore,

Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

Section 1. The members of the Senate commend and acknowledge Boyd County Schools, Campbellville Independent Schools, Daviess County Schools, Dawson Springs Independent Schools, Fort Thomas Independent Schools, Livingston County Schools, Muhlenberg County Schools, and Pulaski County Schools for their leadership and pursuit of academic excellence, and encourage continued success of these eight exemplary districts.
