### Daycare Report

- The daycare is currently enrolled with 17 kids.
  - 8 Infants
  - 9 Toddlers/Preschoolers

### Early Childhood Learning

- Enrollment as of Friday, April 21st
  - ½ Day Preschool: 76
  - Full Day Blended Preschool with Children Inc. 19
  - Head Start: 20
- We have been selected for \$25,000 Scripps Grant. We are currently working through what that's looking like. We are expanding Book-a-Week from birth- 1<sup>st</sup> grade at some capacity.
- We had our Early Childhood Jamboree on April 19<sup>th</sup>. We have 27 families and 12 agencies
- We are on Week 28 of Book-a-Week. We have given out 3,360 books to our preschool and Head Start students.
- March 1 Adjustment Numbers have allowed us to sustain 2.5 teachers, full time SLP, 3 preschool para educators, and our Early Childhood Community Connector for the 2017-2018 School Year.
