Discussion:

Mrs. Lisa Baird made the following statement.

When Mrs. Stanley was hired, her salary was based on her experience with our district, although a "first time" superintendent. After her most recent review, an extension of her contract was brought up. Due to the election year and potential new board members, our attorney, Mrs. Bird, advised us that that decision and discussion would have to wait until the new board was sworn in. You may remember a "vote of confidence" was given at the end of the year to signify the previous board's thoughts and approval. Before today's meeting, myself and Mrs. Bird did extensive research as to contracts, salaries, size of districts, close proximity to Henderson and ranking of schools by an independent review source. That information was individually shared with all board members. Based on her performance, the performance of the district, and the data received regarding similar districts and the knowledge that Mrs. Stanley would very much like to complete the Strategic Plan goal that she set out to accomplish, our collective belief is that Mrs. Stanley's contract that ends June 30, 2018 be renewed for three (3) years with the following changes: A change in salary to \$145,000 a year; and a change in provided annuity contribution to \$10,000 a year. That contract will conclude June 30, 2021. Dr. Sally Sugg stated that Mrs. Stanley has given our organization organizational direction, faced budget challenges and put the dollar closest to the students. Mr. Mike Waller is support of the contract and stated that it's well worth it. Mrs. Tracey Williams said that she had two main goals and they have both happened. Her goals were to have a superintendent that was more in touch with the students daily and more in touch with staff and their concerns. Mrs. Williams stated that we are very fortunate to have Mrs. Stanley.
