- Transparency of Data Work toward highest level of Transparency of the District's Financial data.
 - Continue push of full Transparency of all District Financial Data and the processes which generate this financial data.
 - Improvements to access and user friendliness.
 - > Identify and analyze current Budgeting Principles.
 - Underestimating Revenue
 - Overestimating Expenses
 - Budget pegged to previous year's budget versus audited actual
 - Fund Balance goals
- Reporting of Data Work toward providing School Board Members with "best of breed" financial/budget reports.
 - Research and discuss with Board Members for "wish list" of reports.
 - > Research effective reporting from other Large Urban School districts.
 - The goal is to provide data in a way that gives Members a high level of confidence in performing their fiduciary responsibility of financial oversight of the budget and the processes which lead to the final budget.
