Consent Agenda Item (Action Item):

Approval of agreement with Torch Prep an ACT Test Prep to provide ACT practice test to Floyd County Juniors, aggregated data results, and two day ACT blitz for juniors.

Fiscal/Budgetary Impact:

The cost to the district for the 2017-2018 school year will be \$48,000.00, seventy-five percent of the total cost. The schools will pay the additional twenty-five percent, \$16,000.00, and their individual cost will be based on the number of Juniors enrolled in their school. This cost includes an ACT Pre-Assessment, aggregated data results, and a two day ACT blitz for each school.

History/Background:
