- Summer learning is underway at Lincoln Elementary School - Learning does not stop at Lincoln when summer time comes. We are offering a multitude of summer learning opportunities for our students this summer:
 - June 5th – June 16th – Intermediate Summer School
 - June 5th – July 7th - 21st Century Summer Program
 - June 6th – June 22nd – Preschool Summer School
 - June 12th – Chess Camp Week
 - June - Preschool Speech Camp
 - July 10th – August 3rd - Me and My School – (incoming kindergarten students)
 - July 24th – August 4th – Primary Boot Camp
- Several LES teachers are taking part in learning opportunities this summer. Including:

- Lincoln had 16 teachers and administrators attend the KYCCBD Behavior Institute on June 12th – 13th. During the two-day workshop we attended various sessions focused on research-based interventions and strategies for working with students with challenging behaviors and or mental health needs. We received great feedback from the staff that attended.
- We wrote and received the *Early Childhood Living Initiative Grant* through the Commissioner of Public Health's office in the amount of \$40,000. This was the largest amount granted to any single school. These funds will be used for:
 - Parent Education and Engagement
 - Focus on Improving Exercise/Nutrition
 - Pre-K through 4th Grade Substance Abuse, Tobacco & Alcohol Prevention Education
- The SBDM council and school administration have been busy hiring new staff members for the 2017 – 2018 school year. We have almost every position filled and are excited about our new and energetic teachers that will be joining our team.
- We continue to look into adding additional clubs/afterschool opportunities for the upcoming school year for our students. Initial plans include:
