

TELL Survey Results

Henderson County Schools 2017

- 97.77% of our certified staff responded
- The District results are a compilation from each school
- All 13 schools participated and received data results
- 85 total questions
- TELL Survey is broken into 9 categories:
 - Time
 - Facilities and Resources
 - Community Support and Involvement
 - Managing Student Conduct
 - Teacher Leadership
 - School Leadership
 - School Council
 - Professional Learning
 - Instructional Practices and Support
- 72% of the questions scored higher than the state average
- 88% of the questions scored higher on the 2017 survey than the 2015 survey
- *“Overall my school is a good place to work and learn”* scored 90.7% agreement in 2017 compared to 88.4% agreement in 2015.
- Categories of focus and discussion: Time and Managing Student Behavior
- Categories of celebration and continuation: Facilities and Resources, Community Support and Involvement, Teacher Leadership, School Leadership, School Council, Professional Learning, and Instructional Practices and Support

How do we use the data?

- Superintendent had conversation with each principal about his or her school results. Each principal will choose an area of growth for his or her 2017-2018 Professional Growth Plan.
- Every principal came to the meeting prepared to discuss and will include goals and strategies in their School Improvement Plan.
- Principals will have conversation with their staff in July/August to discuss results.
- District will include growth areas in District Improvement Plan.
