







## First-Year Percent Increase




### Annual Average Number of MSE AP QS







Tuition Value of AP: Impact of Open Enrollment and Implementation of the AdvanceKentucky Model
Class of **2012** and **2013** 

2842 Qualifying Scores (QS)

x 2 QS per student

X 800 Average Tuition Cost Per Course

\$4,500,000

Given average in-state tuition rates and an average of three credit hours earned per qualifying score, expanding access to AP MSE courses saved AdvanceKentucky students approximately \$4,500,000 more in college tuition than their control group peers.











Longitudinal Research: Matched-Pairs Individuals taking one or more AP exam Class of **2012** and **2013**: **Minority** 












Longitudinal Research: Matched-Pairs Individuals earning one or more AP QS Class of **2012** and **2013**: **Minority** 












Longitudinal Research: Matched-Pairs Individuals taking one or more AP exam Class of **2012** and **2013**: Low Income




















# Number of Kentucky Students taking AP Exams and Earning Qualifying Scores

(All Subjects | Public Schools)














# Performance on Plan and ACT








# College GPAs

Longitudinal Research Class of 2009 | Comparison Group
















