Day 1 – Wednesday, June 13, 2018

Meals: Bottled water & snacks aboard motorcoach, \$10 Dinner Allotment

5:30 am Coaches arrive for loading at South Livingston Elementary. Students should pack a sack lunch!
6:00 am Meet and Greet by your Entourage Management Tour Director. Depart for Springfield, IL.

10:30 am Arrive in **Springfield** and check in at the **Lincoln Home.**

10:45 am Lincoln Home, purchased by Abraham Lincoln and his wife, Mary Todd Lincoln in 1844, was the

only home that Lincoln ever owned. The Lincoln home was built in 1839 as a one-and-a-half story cottage. The house was later expanded by the Lincoln family to a full two-stories. During the time he lived here, Lincoln was elected to the House of Representatives in 1846, and elected President

in 1860.

11:45 am Walk to **Abraham Lincoln Presidential Museum**.

12:00 pm Enjoy your sack lunch on the lawn outside the Lincoln Presidential Museum

12:45 pm Abraham Lincoln Presidential Museum, a state-of-the-art facility carefully designed with

exacting historical detail. Amazingly well-preserved artifacts tell the entire life story of our nation's 16th President. Dedicated to the life and legacy of Abraham Lincoln, the Presidential Museum, unlike any other in the U.S., features hi-tech exhibits, interactive displays, and multimedia programs, as well as a reproduction of the White House as it looked in 1861.

2:45 pm Walk to the Illinois State Capitol.

3:00 pm Illinois State Capitol, located in Springfield, Illinois, is the building that houses the executive and

legislative branches of the government of the U.S. state of Illinois. The current structure, which is covered in zinc to provide a silvery façade which does not weather, is the sixth to serve as capitol since Illinois became a part of the United States in 1818. The capitol is in the architectural style of the French Renaissance and was designed by an architecture and design firm based in Chicago.

3:45 pm Transfer by motorcoach to **Lincoln Tomb.**

4:00 pm Lincoln Tomb is the final resting place of the 16th President of the United States, Abraham

Lincoln, his wife, Mary Todd Lincoln, and three of their four sons. It is located in Oak Ridge Cemetery in Springfield, Illinois. At the close of the events marking Lincoln's death, his body was placed in a nearby receiving tomb and later in the state tomb. The mausoleum is owned and administered by the State of Illinois as Lincoln Tomb State Historic Site. It was designated one of the first National Historic Landmarks in 1960, and thus became one of the first sites listed on the

National Register of Historic Places in 1966, when that designation was created.

CANCELLATION POLICY

Initial Here

<u>Group Cancellation.</u> If the entire group cancels after **October 20, 2017**, there will be a **\$1,000.00** cancellation penalty plus any non-recoverable expenses. If the group has elected to process online registration payments through Entourage Management, any credit card or e-check processing fees incurred for deposit payments processed prior to the cancellation of the group will be billed back to the school. These costs will be passed back to the school for cancellations received at any time.

Individual cancellations are subject to the following cancellation penalties:

Up to 90 days prior Refund less \$25.00 administrative fee and any non-coverable expenses

89 - 60 days prior 25% cancellation penalty 59 - 45 days prior 50% cancellation penalty

44 - 00 days prior No refund

Tour Cancellation Fee Waiver Protection will be offered to individual participants at an additional cost of \$39.00 per person. This protection will waive the cancellation penalties and non-refundable fees involved in the trip in the event that a person needs to cancel due to documented illness, injury, or death in the immediate family. This trip protection is a non-refundable fee, payable with the initial booking deposit.

HELPFUL CHAPERONE TIPS

- Give POSITIVE support to the group especially after a performance.
- Acknowledge positive behavior and be FAIR with the students you supervise.
- Although the primary concern is helping all students, a chaperone's primary concern is to those directly under their supervision.
- Show your students TRUST by giving them some freedom when possible.
- Become GENUINELY interested in your students as you get to know them on a personal level.
- PROVIDE an outlet for individual students to talk over problems with you.
- Provide a good EXAMPLE at all times. Remember that students will mirror what they see from adults.
- Help dispel RUMORS through investigation. Do not repeat rumors that seem to be common on trips.
- Be CONSISTENT with the rules and regulations of the group.
- SUPPORT and ENCOURAGE the music faculty. They are dedicated individuals who have worked hard to make the trip possible for the students.
- Do things in pairs and be visible.
- Do not complain in front of the students or change established policies for the trip.
- Do not hesitate to volunteer your services when needed.
- Do not grant "special" favors to the students who are under your direct supervision.
- Students wish to be treated like adults. You don't need to hand hold.
- Separate yourself from your own son or daughter unless he or she asks for your assistance.
- 🦫 Do not use improper language or engage in any other negative behavior when students are present.
- Do not engage in ALCOHOL or DRUG RELATED activity while chaperoning our students.
- Have a good time and ENJOY yourself, but remember that your first responsibility is always to the group.



MOTORCOACH TRANSPORTATION

Coach Features. Each coach features Wifi (limited service), DVD player, PA System, 110V Plug Ins, on board restroom, comfortable seating, and the services of a professional driver. Each motorcoach will be inspected upon departure and return of the trip. Any damage is the responsibility of the school / organization. Damages will be assessed and charged accordingly. Motorcoaches that require unusual cleaning will be the cause for an additional \$100.00 charge.

Wi-Fi. Although Wi-fi service is offered on board the motorcoach you can expect it NOT to work consistently or occasionally, at all, during the trip. We will advise participants on the trip to bring their own Hot Spot if they require regular access to Wi-Fi on the trip. We cannot guarantee this service for you.

Driver Hours Limitations. The Department of Transportation provides specific guidelines for your driver's on duty and off duty time. Drivers can be on duty a total of 15 hours; 10 of which are allowed for driving. A full 9 hour break is required between shifts. We have planned your itinerary to stay within these guidelines. If there are traffic issues or delays, we may have to adjust your schedule to accommodate the drivers legal driving time limits. Certificate of Insurance. Prior to your trip departure we will have the motorcoach company issue a Certificate of Insurance listing the School as additional insured on the policy. Typically, we will have these certificates issued at the beginning of the new year so that the policy dates are current for your date of travel.

Motorcoach Loading Crews. It is the responsibility of each group to load/unload their baggage on the motorcoach. We request that you arrange for loading crews in advance of your departure date. Loading crews will ensure that the coach is packed tightly and smartly so that you can utilize the space in the best possible manner.

Driver Gratuities. For your convenience, driver gratuities are included in your tour package. Additional gratuities or driver thank you gifts are at your own discretion.
