- Previous class placement
- Middle school teacher recommendation
- Attendance (95%)
- Other Assessments as appropriate (70%)
- ❖ Student and parental input with consultation from LCHS administration
- ❖ Policy 10.01 Student Assignment Policy will be used for advising as well.
