At least three points of data that meet proficiency (70%) which could include, but not be limited to the following may be used to determine the most appropriate placement:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">❖ Algebra 1 End of Course exam results (70%)❖ Renaissance Learning STAR Math (70%)❖ Grades from 8th grade math course (Must have an A or B average for year)❖ Previous class placement❖ Middle school teacher recommendation❖ Attendance (95%)❖ Other Assessments as appropriate (70%)❖ Student and parental input with consultation from LCHS administration❖ Policy 10.01 Student Assignment Policy will be used for advising as well.
