 - 2017 to be held October 23rd
- ParentCamp was formalized as a non-profit in Kentucky in 2016
- ParentCamps have been held in many states across the U.S. with a number of them on the schedule for this fall and next spring.

First ParentCampNKY held June 24, 2017 at Boone County High School.

- Approximately 50 attendees parents, teachers, district leaders, advocates, community members and resources
- Purpose was to provide an opportunity to build relationships and support systems for families along with connecting them to resources.













