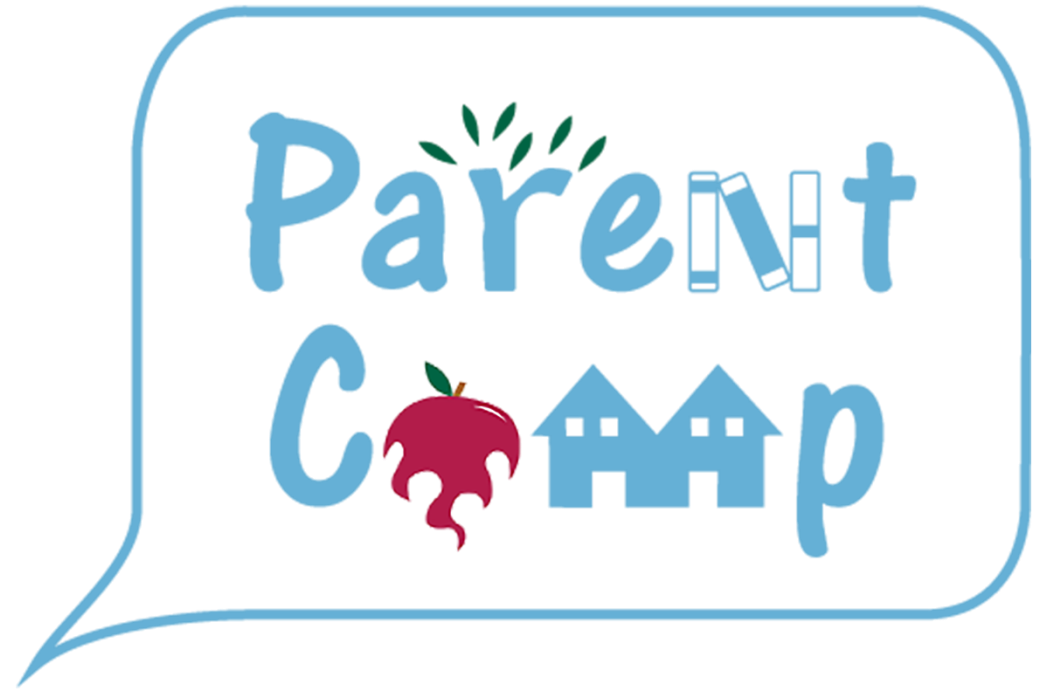


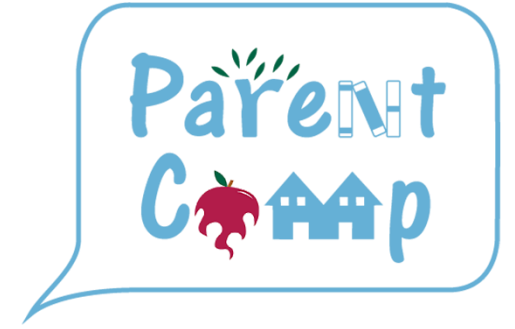

- First ParentCamp held at Knapp Elementary in Lansdale, Pennsylvania following an EdCamp.
  - The one main difference between an EdCamp and a ParentCamp is knowledge level of the facilitator for the session and it is best to have most sessions preplanned.
- There have been four ParentCamps held at the US Department of Education since 2015
  - 2016's focused on World Cultures and Literacy Outcomes
  - 2017 to be held October 23<sup>rd</sup>
- ParentCamp was formalized as a non-profit in Kentucky in 2016
- ParentCamps have been held in many states across the U.S. with a number of them on the schedule for this fall and next spring.

# First ParentCampNKY held June 24, 2017 at Boone County High School.

- Approximately 50 attendees – parents, teachers, district leaders, advocates, community members and resources
- Purpose was to provide an opportunity to build relationships and support systems for families along with connecting them to resources.

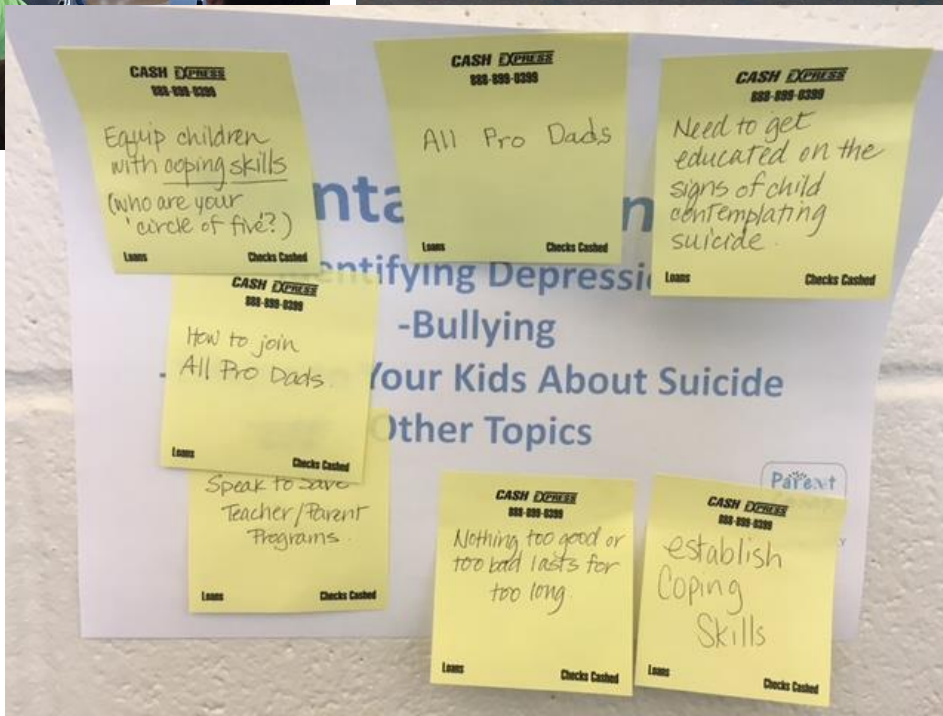
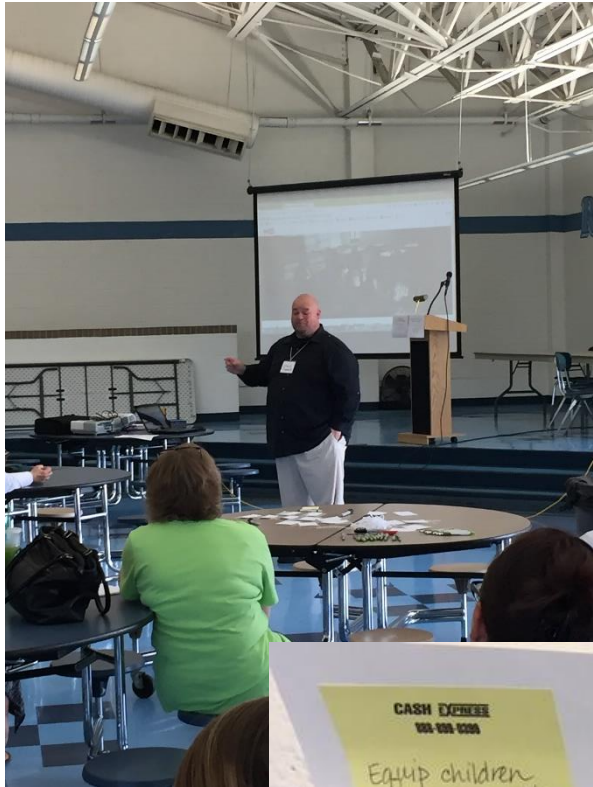
